At A Glance**

Achievement

- Increased student learning
- Measured by a variety of local, district, and state assessments

Focused on:

- Increasing the use of research-based teaching strategies
- “The right tool for the job.”
- Monitoring student progress on high-leverage standards and providing intervention when appropriate
- Increasing the number of students reading at or above grade level
 - READ 180, System 44, Leveled Literacy Intervention

Attendance

- Increasing the number of students who attend school 90% of the time
- Measured by daily attendance

Focused on:

- Reducing the number of students who are absent 15+
- Providing intervention for students and families with a history of attendance concerns

Behavior

- Decreasing the number of referrals resulting in ISAP (ISS) or OSS

Focused on:

- Communicating expectations for behavior
- Recognizing students for positive behavior and improvement
- Teaching expected behaviors
- Exploring restorative discipline practices
- Providing supports for students
- Reducing incidents of bullying as reported by students on the climate survey

Climate

- Increase the number of positive responses to the staff, student, and parent climate surveys

Focused on:

- Increasing the number of students who respond positively to the following:
 - There is an adult at school who cares about me
 - I like going to school here
